Evaluation of ASRGs and other NASA-developed technologies



- Does the proposal demonstrate that the mission is enabled by the use of an ASRG(s)?
- Does the proposal demonstrate understanding of the NASA developed technology, its risks (and any mitigations), its Technology Readiness Level, and have a convincing plan for its implementation?
- The TMC panel will receive briefings on the offered NASA-developed technologies.

Evaluation of Deep Space Network (DSN) Usage



- Does the proposal demonstrate that the use of NASA's network services is clearly within the capabilities and capacities described in the NASA's Mission Operations and Communications Services document? If not, does it include a Letter of Commitment from the NASA network provider?
- Use of more than one 34m dish is only allowed for station hand-offs, critical event coverage, emergency services, radio science measurements, or navigation observations (e.g., delta-DOR).
